

PERRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
March 24, 2026

The Perry County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m., as was duly advertised. Commissioners: President Randy Cole (RC), Vice President Pam Janniczky (PJ), and Rebecca Thorn (RT) were in attendance. Deputy Auditor Leisa Ecker was also present. There was no *Attorney, Sheriff or News Representative* in attendance.

The meeting opened with all present reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA

RT made a motion to approve the agenda as modified, seconded by PJ. Motion carried 3-0.

COMMISSIONERS

a) Sign Contract with WTH

RC stated this contract is concerning errors on the GIS system. With Eagle View, there were approximately 1,500 properties that need to have numbers changed or modified. There are several of them where the boundaries and the property owners are not properly identified.

RC stated that WTH, who is the vendor, has provided a price of \$6,500 to take the system off-line for 30 days and correct it. Then all these errors will be corrected, so that Eagle View, when the County gets its overview flight in, actually matches the parcels correctly. RC added that if the county wants to have a usable service, then this is something that needs to be done.

RC suggested to pay for this out of the leftover CEDIT money, and get them started on the process.

RT made a motion to approve, seconded by PJ. Motion carried 3-0.

b) Open Community Project bids

RT asked that RC read where this paving will be:

Girl Sout Road from Cannelton City Limits to Sugar Maple Road and Silverpoint Road from Sugar Maple Road to Girl Scout Road and Sybil Road from Silverpoint Road to Dead End and Sheena Road from Silverpoint Road to Dead End at culvert and Swallow Road from Scout Road to Dead End and Shiloh Road from State Road 37 to Dead End.

Bids were received from the following:

RC stated that apparently the low bidder is C & R Construction at this time. The Commissioners need to go through their bid package, and take it under advisement.

RT made a motion to take this under advisement, and if everything is in order and the funding is available, the Commissioners will sign a contract with C & R Construction, seconded by PJ. Motion carried 3-0.
