

ORDINANCE NO. 0-C-22-3

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE  
PERRY COUNTY PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT BOARD OF APPEALS**

WHEREAS, the Indiana Code §6-1.1-28-1 requires that each county have a county property tax assessment board of appeals composed of individuals who are at least eighteen (18) years of age and knowledgeable in the valuation of property; and

WHEREAS, under said statute, the County Commissioners may elect to have a county property tax assessment board of appeals consisting of three (3) or five (5) members; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code contains certain other requirements regarding the county property tax assessment board of appeals.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana as follows:


1. The Perry County Property Tax Assessment Board of Appeals shall consist of five (5) members appointed in accordance with Indiana Code §6-1.1-28-1, as may be amended from time to time.
2. Pursuant to Indiana Code, the fiscal body or the Board of Commissioners may waive the requirement that certain members be certified Level 2 or Level 3 assessor-appraisers if the circumstances warrant.


This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February,

2022.


