**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF PERRY COUNTY, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CDBG GRANT APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana recognize the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits: and

WHEREAS, The Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low-and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana has conducted a public hearing prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearing is to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low-and moderate-income residents:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana that: The Board of Commissioner's President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the completion of a COVID-19 Response, Phase 3 and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
